### HOW MANY?

**PraiReadogs = 50 registered / ReaDingos = 246 registered**

### SUPER READERS: PraiReadogs (ages 3 to 5)

PraiReadogs did not read for rewards from our prize case but were invited to the end-of-SRC-party if they read at least 25 books. For this age group, most were "read-to" rather than reading on their own.
